



## **WATER TREATMENT (Levels 1 & II) & UTILITY OPERATOR**

The Water Treatment & Utility Operator will be responsible for overseeing the activities and processes that go into treating and distributing municipal drinking water, performing skilled and semi-skilled maintenance work, and operating a variety of equipment in the operation, repair and maintenance of Town water, sewer and drainage facilities & systems.

Applicants must have either Level 1 or II Water treatment Certification or be approaching completion. The preferred candidates will also have Water distribution and Wastewater collection certificates. Knowledge of the principles, standards and practices of the SCADA program is a strong asset.

Applicants will also be required to perform the various duties of the Public Works Department including maintaining roads when the need arises, giving priority to the Town's water system.

The successful candidates are required to supply a criminal record check and a copy of their credentials.
